The City of Galena Park is situated east of the City of Houston, south of Jacinto City, west of the tip of Galveston Bay, and north of the Houston Ship Channel leading to the Port of Houston, which ranks first in foreign waterborne tonnage and second in total tonnage in the United States. The City is served by two major municipal airports – William P. Hobby and George Bush Intercontinental. The City is surrounded by a growing network of freeways and also has an ample rail access. We are in close proximity to the world-prestigious Texas Medical Center and NASA's Johnson Space Center.


